Target Group

Employees of companies regularly involved in project making or actively involved in projects. Experience in leading projects is helpful but not a pre-requisite. If your role is one of being on the periphery of projects, perhaps in project administration or as sponsor, then Foundation level prepares you for the role as project manager.

Course Goals

This course imparts the elementary principles of the PRINCE2™ project management method and prepares you to the PRINCE2™ Foundation exam.

Results

Upon completion of this training you will be able to:

- Understand the PRINCE2™ methodology.
- Learn how to set up a project management organization that is responsible for managing and planning the project.
- Use the PRINCE2™ methodology from the preparation of a project, during a project and monitoring a project.
- Demonstrate the relationship between projects and recognise the daily management of an organisation, and understand the reasons for success and failure of a project.
- Produce written and detailed communication with the sponsors and the project organisation.

Program

Partial day 1: Introduction, PRINCE2™ overview, starting up a project.

Partial day 2: Project based planning, business case.

Partial day 3: Setting up project controls, component risk management.

Partial day 4: Managing product delivery.

Partial day 5: Process directing a project sub-processes.

Partial day 6: Exam PRINCE2™ Foundation.
